### RLJ Lodging Trust Announces 2014 Dividend Income Tax Information

Bethesda, MD, January 30, 2015 – RLJ Lodging Trust (the “Company”) (NYSE: RLJ) today announced the 2014 tax classification of the dividend distributions made to the Company’s holders of its common shares of beneficial interest.

The 2014 fourth quarter distribution of \$0.300, which had a record date of December 31, 2014, will be a split-year distribution. For tax purposes, \$0.180 will be allocated to the 2014 Form 1099-DIV and the remaining \$0.120 will be allocated to the 2015 Form 1099-DIV.

No portion of the 2014 distributions represented capital gains or qualified dividend income.
